BYSTANDER JOHN 5 THE RABBI FROM NAZARETH

This first sign of seven signs.

When Jesus turned water into wine.

These seven signs had a purpose to point people to the identity of Jesus. On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother (Mary) was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine was gone Jesus mother said to him, "They have no more wine."

John 2: 1-3 NIV

"Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Nearby stood six stone water jars, the kind used by Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding twenty to thirty gallons.

John 2: 4-6 NIV

Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim. Then he told them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the banquet." They did so, and the master of the banquet tasted the water that had been turned into wine.

John 2: 7-9 NIV

BYSTANDER JOHN & THE RABBI FROM NAZARETH He (master) did not realize where it had come from, though the servants who had drawn the water knew. "Everyone brings out the choice (fine) wine first and then the cheaper wine after the guests have had too much to drink; but you have saved the best till now."

After this he went down to Capernaum with his mother and brothers and his disciples. There they stayed a few days.
