The day on which this took place was a Sabbath, and so the Jewish leaders said to the man who had been healed. "It is the Sabbath; the law forbids you to carry your mat." But he replied, "The man who made me well said to me, 'Pick up your mat and walk.'" So they asked him, "Who is the fellow who told you to pick it up and walk?" The man who was healed had no idea who it was. for Jesus had slipped away into the crowd that was there. John 5: 9b-13 NIV

For this reason they tried all the more to kill him; not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was even calling God his own Father, making himself equal with God. "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees the Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does," John 5: 18-19 NIV

If you want to know what God is really like?

Jesus is saying ... Watch me! Listen to me! Follow me! "You study the Scriptures diligently because you think that in them (text) you have eternal life. These are the very Scriptures that testify about me (point to Jesus), yet you refuse to come to me to have life."
