Many believed in Jesus.





After this, Joseph for the city of Ramah (Arimathea), who was a secret disciple of Jesus for fear of the Jewish authorities. ask Pilate if he could remove the body of Jesus. So Pilate granted him permission to remove the body from the cross. Now Nicodemus, who had once come to Jesus privately at night. accompanied Joseph, and together they carried a significant amount (75 pounds) of myrrh and aloes to the cross. Then they took Jesus; body and wrapped it in strips of linen with the embalming spices according to the Jewish burial customs. ... And because the Sabbath was approaching, and the tomb nearby, that's where they laid the body of Jesus.

John 19: 38-42 TPT

So she (Mary Magdalene) went running as fast as she could to go tell Peter and the other disciple (i.e. John), the one Jesus loved,

She told them, "They've taken the Lord's body from the tomb, and we don't know where he is!"

Then Peter and the other disciple (John) jumped up and ran to the tomb to go see for themselves.

They started out together, but the other disciple (John) outran Peter and reached the tomb first.

He (John) didn't enter the tomb, but peeked in, and saw only the linen cloths (strips) lying there.

Then Peter came behind him and went right (straight) into the tomb.

He too noticed the linen cloths lying there, but the burial cloth that had been on Jesus' head had been rolled up and placed separate for the other cloths.

Then (finally) the other disciple (John) who had reached the tomb first went in, and after one look (saw), he (John) believed!

One of the twelve wasn't present when Jesus appeared to them it was Thomas, whose nickname was "the Twin."
So the disciples informed him,
"We have seen the Lord (Jesus) with our own eyes!"
Still unconvinced, Thomas replied,
"There's no way I'm going to believe this unless
I personally see the wounds of the nails in his hands,
touch them with my finger,
and put my hand into the wound of his side
where he was pierced!"

John 20: 24-25 TPT



#### Then eight days later, Thomas and all the others were in the house together. And even thought the doors were locked, Jesus suddenly stood before them! "Peace be with you," he said. Then, looking into Thomas' eyes, he said, "Put your finger here in the wounds of my hands. Here put your hand into my wounded side and see for yourself. Thomas, don't give in to your doubts and longer, just believe!" Then the words spilled out of his heart -"You are my Lord, and you are my God!"

John 20: 26-28 TPT

Jesus responded, "Thomas, now that you've seen me, you believe. But there are those (like all of us) who have never seen me with their eyes but have believed me with their hearts. and they are blessed even more!"
