Therefore, if you have any encouragement from being united (all one) with Christ (in Jesus), if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing (fellowship) in the Spirit, if any tenderness (affection) and compassion (mercy), then make my joy complete (unbounded) by being like-minded (walk together), having the same love (one passion), being one in spirit and of one mind.

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. In your relationships with one another have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage;

rather he (Jesus) made (reduced) himself nothing
 by taking the very nature of a (lowly) servant,
 being made in human likeness.
And being found in appearance (revealed) as a man,
 he humbled himself (became vulnerable)
by becoming obedient (perfect example) to death
 - even death (criminal's death) on a cross! ...

4 WAYS TO BE GOOD NEWS

- 1. Apologize immediately.
- 2. Forgive quickly.
- 3. Defer habitually.
- 4. Give sacrificially.
