MESSAGE 8: EQUIPPING EVERYDAY PEOPLE

### God loves to use "unlikely" people!



Then Peter, filled with (the power of) the Holy Spirit, said to them, "Rulers and elders of the people (members of the Sanhedrin, ...), if we are being put on trial (interrogated) today for a good deed done to (benefit) a disabled man, as to how this man has been restored to health, let it be known and clearly understood by all of you, and all of Israel, that in the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, whom you (demanded be) crucified (by the Romans and), whom God raised from the dead in this name (that is, by the authority and power of Jesus) this man stands before you in good health (healed). This Jesus is 'the stone which was despised and rejected by you, the builders, but which became the chief cornerstone.' And there is salvation in no one else; for there is no other name by which we must be saved (for God has provided the world no alternative for salvation)." discovering

Now when the men of the Sanhedrin (Jewish High Court) saw the confidence and boldness of Peter and John, and grasped the fact (discovered) that they were uneducated and untrained (ordinary) men, they were astounded (staggered), and began to recognize (understand) that they had been (spent time) with Jesus. And seeing the man who had been healed standing there with them, they had nothing to say in reply.

God loves using "ordinary" and "unlikely" people to do his work because there is no way they can boast before him. God gets all the glory!



Brothers and sisters (fellow believers), consider who you were when God called you to salvation. Not many of you were wise scholars by human standards, nor were many of you in positions of power. Not many of you were considered the elite when you answered God's call. But God chose those whom the world considers foolish to shame those who think they are wise, and God chose the puny and powerless to shame (frustrate) the high and mighty. He chose the lowly, the laughable in the world's eyes - nobodies - so that he would shame the somebodies. For he chose what is regarded as insignificant in order to supersede what is regarded as prominent, so that there would be no place for prideful boasting in God's presence. discovering

"We know movements (DMMs) often happen through ordinary, unlikely people being filled with the Spirit of God and boldly going out among the lost to make disciples and see churches planted. This reminds me of what I've heard from movement practitioners (Catalysts) around the world. They always say not to guess who you think God is going to use to catalyze a movement. It's often unlikely people you wouldn't have picked. Therefore, train everyone, and then watch to see who GOD uses! It will often be an unlikely person you wouldn't have expected.
