Jesus' new covenant commandment (love law) established the governing ethic for his new movement. It was simple but all-encompassing. It was far less complicated than the current system (old covenant) but far more demanding. As you will discover, the imperatives we find scattered throughout the New Testament are simply applications of Jesus' new covenant command (love law). These New Testament imperatives (essentials) are examples of how to love the "one anothers" Jesus commanded us to love. Again, far less complicated. But far more demanding. There are no loopholes in the love Jesus requires of us.
