#### MESSAGE 9: WHAT IS CHURCH?

Where does the word "church" come from and what does it mean?



When Jesus came to Caesarea Philippi, he asked his disciples this question: "What are the people saying about me, the Son of Man? Who do they believe (say) I am? They (disciples) answered, "Some are convinced you are John the Baptizer, others say you are Elijah reincarnated, or Jeremiah, or one of the prophets." "But you – who do you say (believe) that I am?" Jesus asked. Simon Peter spoke up and said, "You are the Anointed One, the Son of the living God!"

Where do we see the first "church" and what did they do?



Every believer was faithfully devoted to following the teachings of the apostles. Their hearts were mutually linked to one another, sharing communion and coming together regularly for prayer. A deep sense of holy awe swept over everyone, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. All the believers were in fellowship as one body, and they shared with one another whatever they had. Out of generosity they even sold their assets to distribute the proceeds to those who were in need (poor) among them. Daily they met together in the temple courts and in one another's homes to celebrate communion. They shared meals together with joyful hearts and tender humility. They were continually filled with praises to God, And the Lord kept adding to their number daily those who were coming to life (being saved).

### **ELEMENTS OF "BEING" THE CHURCH**

- Devoted to obeying Jesus.
- Hearts were "mutually linked."
- Shared communion and meals in homes.
- Gathered regularly for prayer.
- Performed signs and wonders.
- Demonstrated generosity that earned favor.
- Continually filled with praise to God.
- Focused on the Harvest (Lost Sheep).
