# JESUS FOLLOWER

*Now when Jesus saw the **crowds**,  
he went up on the mountainside  
and sat down.*

*His **disciples** (followers) came to him,  
and he began to **teach** them.*

Matthew 5: 1-2 NIV



*When Jesus **finished** saying these things,  
the **crowds** were **amazed** at his teaching,  
because he taught as one who had **authority**,  
and not as their teachers of the law.*

*When Jesus came down  
from the mountainside,  
**large** crowds **followed** him.*

Matthew 7: 28-29 & 8:1 NIV





*A man with leprosy (leper)  
came and knelt before him and he said,  
“Lord if you are willing,  
you can make me clean.”  
Jesus reached out and touched the man.  
“I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!”  
Immediately he was cleansed of his leprosy.*

*... For **I myself** am a man under **authority**,  
with **soldiers** under me  
I tell this one, '**Go,**' and he goes;  
and that one, '**Come,**' and he comes.  
When **Jesus** heard this, he was **amazed** ...  
Then Jesus said to the centurion,  
"Go! Let it **be done** just as  
you **believed** it would."*
