## WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

#### THE WORD GOSPEL IN GREEK

Greek noun *euangelion* means "good news". (76x)

Greek verb *euangelizo* means "to announce ...". (54x)

Greek noun euangelos means "messenger of victory".

## GOSPEL DEFINED BY PAUL

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of (make clear) the gospel (good news) I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly (fasten) to the word I preached to you. For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: (1) that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, (2) that he was buried, (3) that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures, (4) and that he appeared ..."

> I Corinthians 15: 1-6a NIV EMPOWERED

## WHAT IS THE GOSPEL OF THE KINGDOM OF GOD?

In those days John the Baptist came preaching in the wilderness of Judea and saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven has come near."

Matthew: 3: 1-2 NIV

After John was put in prison, Jesus went into Galilee, proclaiming the good news of God. "The time has come," he said. "The kingdom of God has come near. Repent and believe the good news!"

#### THE WORD KINGDOM IN GREEK

Greek noun basilea means "kingly rule or reign".

"On the other hand, if I drive out demons by the power of the Spirit of God then the kingdom of God has come upon you!"

Matthew 12: 28 TPT

Jesus went throughout Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom, and healing every (kind of) disease and sickness ...

Matthew 4: 23 NIV

*"Our Father in heaven, hallowed (honored, holy) be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven."* Matthew 6: 9b-10 NIV

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the kingdom of God and healing every disease and sickness.

> Matthew 9: 35 NIV EMPOWERED

When Jesus had called the Twelve together, he gave them power and authority to drive out all the demons and to cure diseases, and he sent them out to proclaim the kingdom of God and to heal the sick.. Luke 9: 1-2 NIV

From the moment John stepped onto the scene until now, the realm of heaven's kingdom is bursting forth (forcefully advancing), and passionate people (the violent ones) have taken hold of its power. Matthew 11: 12 TPT

And the gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.

When Jesus said that the kingdom or rule of God had come in Him, he meant that God had come to claim what was rightfully His. There was a man named Nicodemus, a Jewish religious leader who was a Pharisee. After dark one evening, he came to speak with Jesus. "Rabbi (Master), he said, we all know that God has sent you to teach us. Your miraculous signs are evidence that God is with you." Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, unless you are born again," you cannot see the Kingdom of God." "What do you mean?" exclaimed Nicodemus. "How can an old man go back into his mother's womb and be born again?" Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. ... # HOW SHOULD WE LIVE IN THE KINGDOM?

Since then, we know what it is to fear (stand in awe) the Lord, we (make it our passion) try to persuade others (to turn to him). ... For Christ's love compels (fuels) us, because we are convinced that one died for all, and therefore all died. And he died for all, that those who live should no longer live for themselves but for him who died for them and was raised again. ... Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here! All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation:

### DO NOT LOVE THE WORLD!

Don't set the affections of your heart on this world or in loving the things of the world. The love of the Father and the love of the world are incompatible. For all (everything) that the world can offer us – the gratification of our flesh (lust of the flesh), the allurement of the things of the world (lust of the eyes), and the obsession with status and importance (pride of life) – none of these things come from the Father but from the world.
