COMMON LIES WE BELIEVE

1. You Don't Have "What It Takes."



*This is an easy **lie** to **believe** because there are so many **opportunities** to compare **ourselves** nowadays. Everyone puts the **best version** of themselves on **social media**. I'm trying to get a petition started that changes the name of Facebook and Instagram to **Mirage**. Maybe then we wouldn't look at these **airbrushed** versions of people's **lives** and feel so **insecure**. We **compare** our normal **lives** with the **highlights** of an **idealized version** of other people's **lives** and we feel like we **fall short**. We start to **think** we don't have "**what it takes**". That's **not** true. It's **not** true because what you're **seeing** on social media is mostly **not true**.*

BELIEVE THE “**SELF-FIX-IT**” LIE

*We refuse to **ask** for help, ...*

*We **hide** our **mistakes** and **weaknesses**, ...*

*We think **God** is unnecessary (**optional**).*

When you believe the “**Self-Fix-It**” lie ...

*You become **prideful**.*

*You **minimize** (downsize) **problems**.*

*You **lose** relational **intimacy**.*

*You **create** a **façade** (live a lie).*



Now that we *know* what we have – *Jesus*,
this great High Priest (*King-Priest*) with ready *access* to God
- let's not let it (*faith*) slip through our fingers (*hold firmly*).
We don't have a *priest* who is out of touch with *our reality*.
He's been through *weakness* and *testing* (temptations),
experienced it all (*sympathize*) – all but *the sin*.
So let's walk right up (*turn*) to him (*Jesus*)
and *get* what he is *ready* to *give*.
Take the *mercy*, accept the *help*.
