#### SIX FACTORS OF DECLINE

- 1. Inflated: The Church is smaller than we think.
- 2. Hated: Accelerating anti-Christian culture.
- 3. Dividing: Splitting on politics & social justice.
- 4. Bankrupt: Dependent on decreasing dollars.
- Bleeding: Young people & others are leaving.
- 6. Sputtering: Not reaching new people.



"What is truly remarkable is that even with loads of money being deposited into the evangelical movement, it hasn't kept the evangelical church from shrinking. Despite the billions of dollars invested in churches and ministries all across our nation, evangelicalism has not kept pace with the population growth. 

## Understanding the Long Tail







### The "Mindset" of Paul



God always makes his grace visible in Christ (Jesus), who includes us as partners (captives) in his endless triumph (triumphal procession). Through our yielded lives he spreads the fragrance (aroma) of the knowledge of God everywhere we go. We have become the unmistakable (sweet) aroma of the victory of the Anointed One (Jesus) to God a perfume of life to those being saved and the odor of death to those perishing. ... And who can rise to this challenge?

2 Corinthians 2:14-16a TPT



For your very lives are our letters of recommendation, permanently engraved (written) on our hearts, recognized and read by everybody (all people).
... you are living letters written by Christ (Jesus), not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God - not carved onto stone tablets but on the tablets of tender hearts.

2 Corinthians 3:2-3 TPT



Even if our gospel message is veiled,
it is only veiled to those who are perishing,
for their minds have been blinded
by the god of this age (Satan),
leaving them in unbelief.
Their blindness keeps them from seeing
the dayspring light (flame of the good news) ...
Since we are those who stand in holy awe of the Lord,
we make it our passion to persuade others to turn to him.

If we are out of our minds ..., it is for God, ... For it is Christ's (Jesus') love that fuels our passion and motivates (compels) us, because we are absolutely convinced that he (Jesus) has given his life for all of us. This means all died with him, so those who live should no longer live self-absorbed lives but lives that are poured out for him - the one who died for us and now lives again. Now (Therefore), if anyone is enfolded into (in) Christ he has become an entirely new creation. All that is related to the old order (identity) has vanished. Behold, everything is fresh and new.

2 Corinthians 5:14-15, 17 TPT

And God has made all things new, and reconciled us to himself, and given us the ministry of (reconciliation) reconciling others to God. In other words, it was through the Anointed One (Jesus) that God was shepherding (reconciling) the world (all people), Not even keeping records of their transgressions (sins), and he entrusted (committed) to us the ministry (message) of opening the door of reconciliation to God. We are ambassadors of the Anointed One (Jesus) who carry the message of Christ (Jesus) to the world, ... "Turn back to God (repent) and be reconciled to him."
