If God is good, ... why is there so much suffering in the world? why do bad things happen to good people?


If God were all-powerful ... or all-loving ... he could/would eliminate suffering.


So, is God unable or unwilling?

Follow up Questions: Have you ever done anything bad? How about your kids? How about your parents?
