HEARING GOD'S WORD

Do you have a regular pattern in your life of reading (hearing) the Word of God?



My son (child), give attention (focus) to my words;

Never substitute knowledge about God for an obedient relationship with God.



"Knowing the correct password - saying 'Master, Master,' ... - isn't going to get you anywhere with me. What is required is serious obedience doing what my Father wills. I can see it now - at the Final Judgement thousands strutting up to me and saying, 'Master, we preached the Message, we bashed the demons, our God-sponsored projects (i.e. miracles) had everyone talking." And do you know what I'm going to say? 'You missed the boat. (I never knew you) All you did was use me to make yourselves important. You don't impress me one bit. You're out of here.' Knowing and obeying (doing) are two very different things.



"If you work these words into your life (put them to practice) You are like a smart (wise) carpenter who built his house on solid rock (bedrock). But if you just use my words in Bible studies and don't work them out in your life (obey them), you are like a stupid (foolish) carpenter who built his house on the sandy beach (sand). When a storm rolled in and the waves came up, It collapsed like a house of cards.
