# SCATTERED SERVANTS

MESSAGE 2:  
EVERYONE EVERYDAY



When Jesus got to that place (*spot*), he *looked up* in the tree and said, "*Zacchaeus*, hurry on down, for I *must stay* at your *house* today." So he *scurried* down the tree and found himself *face-to-face* with Jesus.

As he left to go with Zacchaeus, *many* in the crowd complained (*muttered*), "Look at this! Of all the people to have dinner with, he's *going* to eat in the *house* of a crook (*sinner*)" ...

He sends the **found** into the **world**.*
