## STEPHEN



On that day (Stephen's stoning) a great persecution broke out against the church (The Way) in Jerusalem, and all except the apostles were scattered throughout Judea and Samaria. ... Saul began to destroy the church. Going from house to house, he dragged off both men and women and put them in prison.

So the Jesus movement ceased to be (stopped moving) as both its leaders and the followers of The Way were eventually rounded up and executed.

Now those who had been scattered by the persecution that broke out when Stephen was killed traveled as far as Phoenicia, Cyprus and Antioch, spreading the word only among Jews. Some of them however, men from Cyprus and Cyrene, went to Antioch and began to speak to Greeks also, telling them the good news about the Lord Jesus. The Lord's hand was with them, and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord.

During this time some prophets came down from Jerusalem to Antioch. One of them named Agabus, stood up and through the Spirit predicted that a severe famine would spread over the entire Roman world. (This happened during the reign of Claudius.) Acts 11: 27-28 NIV
