


"Jesus new command signaled a shift from vertical to horizontal. The eye-to-the-sky (vertical) days were coming to an end. The litmus test for being a bona fide Jesus follower was not the ritualistic, day-of-the-week, festival-driven, don't-forgetyour-goat worship of an invisible and somewhat distant God. Following Jesus would not be about looking for ways to get closer to God who dwelled out there, up there, somewhere. Jesus followers would demonstrate their devotion to God by putting the person next to them in front of them. Jesus followers weren't expected to look up (vertical).
