Luke tells us why and how the story of the Bible began.

The story of the Bible begins at the tomb of Jesus.



Now there was a man named Joseph, a member of the Council, a good and upright man, who had not consented to their decision and action. He came from the Judean town of Arimathea. and he himself was waiting for the kingdom of God. Going to Pilate, he asked for Jesus' body. Then he took it down, wrapped it in linen cloth and placed it in a tomb cut in the rock, one in which no one had yet been laid. THE

Luke 23: 50-53 NIV

The women (Mary Magdalene & the other Mary) who had come with Jesus from Galilee followed Joseph and saw the tomb and how his body was laid in it.

Then they went home and prepared spices and perfumes. But they rested on the Sabbath in obedience to the commandment.

Luke 23: 55-56 NIV



After the crucifixion there were no Christians. nobody was a believer.

It was "game over", because everybody had unfollowed.



On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the woman took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb. They found the stone rolled away from the tomb, but when they entered, they did not find the body of Jesus.

While they were wondering about this ...

"Why do you look for the living among the dead?

He is not here; he (Jesus) has risen!

Fellow Israelites, listen to this: Jesus of Nazareth was a man accredited by God to you by miracles, wonders and signs, which God did among you through him (Jesus), as you yourselves know.

This man was handed over to you by God's deliberate plan and foreknowledge; and you, with the help of wicked men, put him to death by nailing him to a cross. But God raised him from the dead,
